POSITION CHARACTERISTICS: Full time, non-seasonal, fully benefited position, including vacation and sick accrual, 13 paid holidays, 1 paid personal day, company sponsored health, dental & life insurance, FLEX spending account, Utah Retirement Systems non-contributory pension fund, URS investment options (401K, 457, IRA) with match, FREE Household membership to facility. Flexible schedule; must be available to work a variety of shifts; day/evening weekdays, Saturdays, Sundays & holidays. Schedule is dictated by needs of the District and needs of Aquatic programs.

POSITIONS DIRECTLY SUPERVISED: Aquatic Shift Leads, Lifeguards.

POSITION PURPOSE: Responsible for ensuring the effective performance of lifeguard functions. Recruit, hire, train, schedule, coordinate, and evaluate lifeguards and Aquatic Shift Leads. Ensure that all required certifications are current and that lifeguards are fully competent in performing water rescue procedures. Ensure the safety of patrons in and around the pool. Ensure that all pools are operating properly. Inform the Physical Facilities Department of any pool maintenance issues and/or repair needs. Assists Aquatic Manager with the overall management of the Aquatics department, as assigned.

BASIC DUTIES:

1. Responsible for the effective performance of Aquatic Shift Leads and Lifeguards.
2. Recruits, hires, schedules, coordinates, evaluates and trains all lifeguarding staff ensuring optimal performance.
3. Works closely with Aquatics Program Supervisor assisting with program needs as necessary.
4. Responsible for maintaining an effective working relationship with the Aquatic Manager and all other managers of the District.
5. Assumes responsibility for other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Current American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer, American Red Cross First Aid, American Red Cross Lifeguard Training. LGI certification within six months of hire date.
2. Minimum of two years aquatic experience which may include: lifeguard duties, swim team experience, teaching, swim lessons, specialty classes, etc.
3. Supervisory experience highly preferred.
4. Strong swimming and lifesaving skills
5. Good leadership and human relations skills
